

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

JPS Virtual Option:

A virtual option through <u>South Central Michigan Virtual (SCMV) Campus</u> is available to your student. SCMV provides a robust curriculum for students Kindergarten through 12th grade. SCMV staff are a team of certified and highly qualified JPS teachers and academic counselors. Your principal will work with you and the SCMV staff to connect your student to virtual learning.

Technology:

All JPS students will be issued one-to-one technology to enhance their in classroom learning. Y5 - 2nd grade students will receive an Ipad and 3rd - 12th grade students will receive a Chromebook.

Current COVID-19 Protocols:

COVID-19 guidelines for the school are set by the Jackson County Health Department (JCHD), Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC).

<u>COVID-19 Positive Students and Staff Regardless of Vaccination Status:</u> Positive COVID-19 cases are required to quarantine with the following guidelines:

 Quarantine for five days and monitor for symptoms from the day of symptom/s onset. If symptoms have improved or you continue to have no symptoms, return to school on the sixth day from positive test/symptoms.

<u>Close Contacts of COVID-19 POSITIVE CASE - Regardless of Vaccination Status or have had COVID-19 in the last 90 days:</u>

- Close contacts of a COVID-19 case DO NOT need to quarantine at home.
- Please monitor symptoms and stay home if not feeling well.
