

JACKSON HIGH SCHOOL TEST OUT

The State of Michigan requires that high schools allow students to “test out” of classes, and, if they score high enough, to receive credit for that course although they did not take the course.

JHS will offer test out opportunities on June 11, 12, 13 and August 6, 7, 8, 2019. Students must apply by June 7 by completing the form below and turning it into Lori Wilgenhof in the main office.

The student must achieve a score of 80% or higher on a test-out exam in order to receive credit for the course. Credit earned will not be included in the computation of the grade point average (GPA).

Students who take, and fail, a course at JHS may try to test out of the course by taking the test-out exam at the next available testing date. If they pass the exam with an 80%, they will receive credit for the course, but the failing grade they already received will be included in their GPA.

Students may not “test out” of a lower level class than one they have already passed for the purpose of adding general credits or for boosting their GPA.
