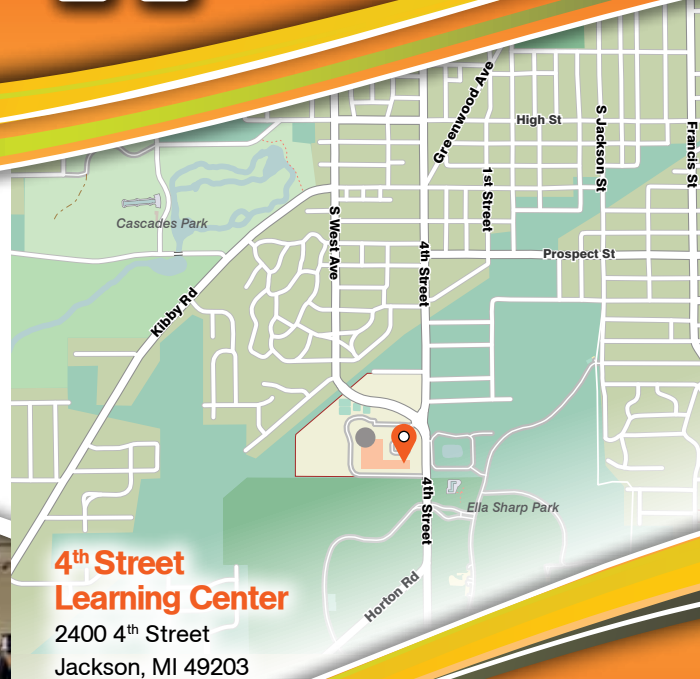

Who We Are

The Fourth Street Learning Center is a JPS school within a school. It is a small learning community designed to offer specialized attention to 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students focusing on the social, emotional, and academic success of students. Through a variety of teaching strategies teachers engage students in non-traditional instructional methods.

The Learning Center is a fully functioning small learning community with a dedicated staff that includes teachers, counselor, para professionals, resource room, administration, and dean of student behavior. The Learning Center is housed in the 100 wing of the Middle School at Parkside.

In this unique, research-based setting students will benefit from smaller class size, a later start time, tremendous access to technology, and a flexible instructional schedule to meet the needs of struggling learners.
