Scholastic Book Adoption

We want to insure that all students have reading materials to successfully be able to complete their reading logs. One of the solutions we have come up with is through Scholastic Book adoption. Free and reduced lunch applications

Be on the look out for the free and reduced lunch application form to come home next week. Even if yo do not think your family will qualify, this is an important form to complete and return; the data collected from this form is what determines our Title 1 funding in the building at our 31A at risk funding for the district. All of these funds are used to support ALL students.

Sharp Park Academy utilized Title I funding to pay for paraprofessionals that work I the classrooms under the guidance of the teachers to provide small group instruction and interventions. Title one funding also pays for our retired teachers who also provide interventions. In addition, out curricular support programs Lexia Core 5 and Success maker are both paid for out of Title I, and cost us about \$45 per student per year. All students in JPS also receive free breakfast and lunch which is a huge benefit to families in terms of convenience!

Transportation and Bussing

If your child is a student who is consistently riding the bus, please make sure they have their bus tags on their backpacks. This helps staff insure that students are boarding the correct busses. Also be aware that due to detours transportation may still be running a little behind. If you are still experiencing problems with stops and insuring your child is on the correct bus, please contact the Bus garage at 841-2180 and inform Mrs. Rigelman of any changes.




